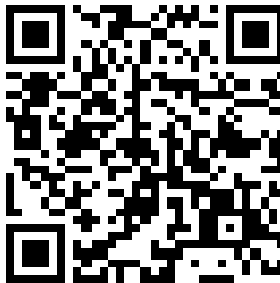

The annual Boy Scouts of America membership fee is less than \$50/year! This fee will include the cost of one annual membership, a subscription to Boys life Magazine (if selected), and liability insurance.



Fees are pro-rated depending on when your child joins and is paid only one-time during registration. You can by check or cash at your first Pack event.



Once your Scout is registered, you should receive a confirmation email. Your Scout may now begin to earn advancement with their Den, and are able to attend additional meetings, events, and overnights with the Pack.
